Eligibility Criteria:

- The applicant must be studying at graduation, post graduation, PhD or higher level.
- The candidate must belong to the SC, ST or General category of Uttar Pradesh to avail of the scholarship benefit.
- The annual family income must not be more than INR 2 lakh

Post matric (Other Than Intermediate) Scholarship for Minorities, Uttar Pradesh

Eligibility Criteria:

- The scholarship is for those students who are pursuing education at graduation, post graduation, PhD or higher level.
- The applicants must belong to the minority community of Uttar Pradesh.
- The annual family income must not be more than INR 2 lakh from all sources.

Post matric (Other Than Intermediate) Scholarship for OBC, Uttar Pradesh
